Year N : Autumn Term

Our theme is Ourselves!

Health

Our focus this term will be on encouraging children to be more independent and to develop their self-help skills. This includes attending to their toileting needs and effectively managing putting on their coats as well as fastening zips and buttons. Please support your child's learning by encouraging independence with these skills at home.

Reading

We encourage parents to come into Nursery and change reading books with their children. These are for you to engage with your child whilst reading aloud. We do not expect children to be able to read these books independently. Reading books and reading records should be kept inside your child's school bag and brought to school every day. Please come into Nursery and change your child's book as often as you wish, but at least once every week. Please make a comment in your child's Reading record for every book you read with your child.

Communication

We will be focusing on developing children's listening and attention skills as well as age appropriate vocabulary. The children will be encouraged to speak in full sentences and use vocabulary focused on objects and people that are of particular importance.

Culture

Nursery theme is 'Ourselves'. Our focus will be building children's confidence, friendships and classroom routines.
