

WHAT ARE WE LEARNING?

Year 6: Autumn Term

The Second World War (investigators)

Health

Physical: Movement. We will focus on running posture and stamina and apply this in team games.

Emotional: The UN Rights of the Child. Setting our goals. Online safety. Stress busting techniques.

Academic

English: We will be reading Goodnight Mr Tom, The Woeful Second World War and Anne Frank's Diary, focussing on understanding new vocabulary. We will be writing a balanced argument, diary entry, a narrative and a non-chronological report.

Maths: Number and place value, addition and subtraction, fractions, decimals and percentages.

Science: Health science – a healthy diet and how physical exercise improves our health.

Technology: Coding and problem solving.

Communication

Vocabulary: pupils will expand and deepen their academic vocabulary and use it in learning.

Performance: pupils will

Speaking and listening: Listening to other's points of view and questions and responding appropriately with constructive criticism and advice.

Culture

The world: WW2 and the British Empire.

Beliefs: pupils will study how religions are formed and how religious persecutions have taken place.

Art: pupils will create several pieces of art based around art from the second world war; they will then create their own art movement.

Music: musical genres and artists such as Vera Lynn and marching songs.

Supporting your child's learning at home

- Family time. Play board games, cook or bake together, play games in the park.
- Read a book with your child. Talk about your favourite parts of the book. Help your child with the parts they do not understand.
- When going to the shops, have your child handle the money, calculate what change they should receive, or how much you are saving on a discount!
