Find missing numbers in scales up to 10 000. Identify and describe rules within number sequences.

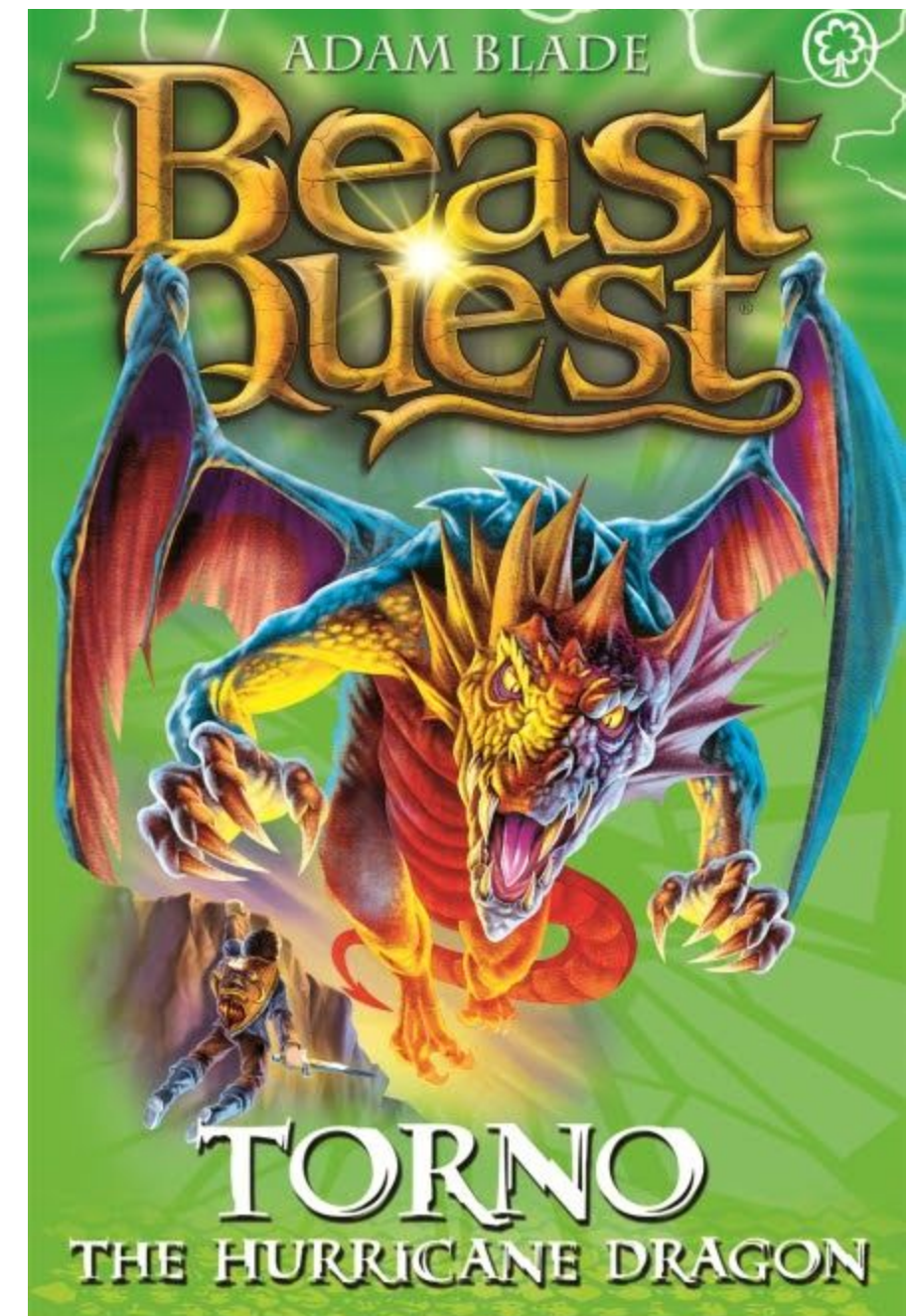
Find 1000 more or less than a given number.
