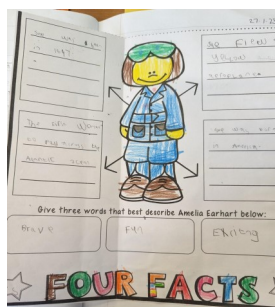
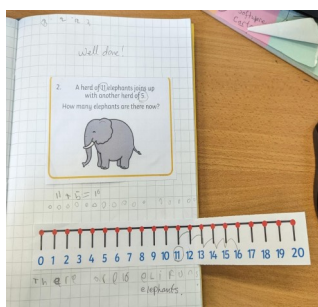

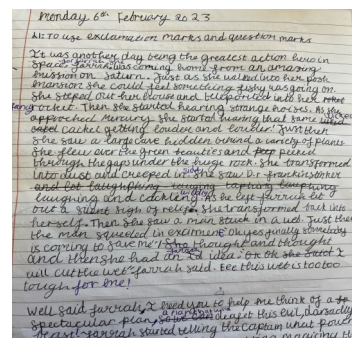
STAR LEARNER OF THE WEEK EYFS & Year 1— Safaa—Y1E

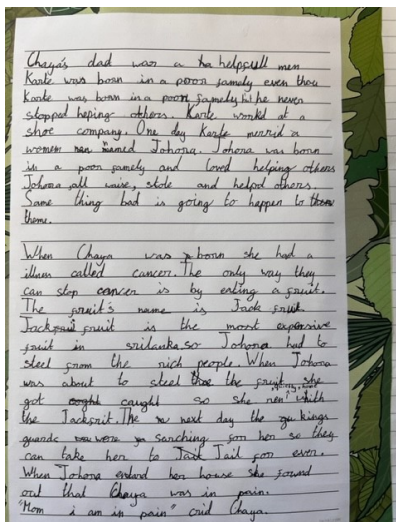
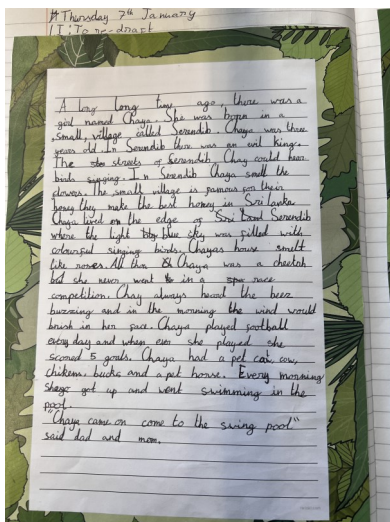
STAR LEARNER OF THE WEEK Year 2- 3— Farrah- Y3B
