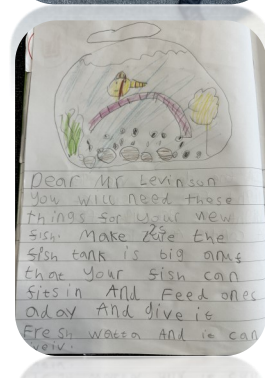
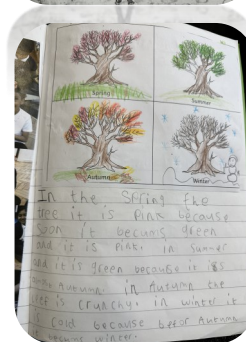
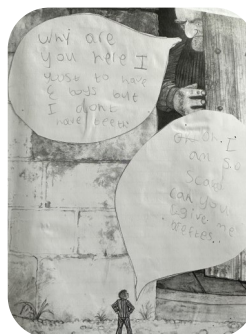


Star Learners this Week are:

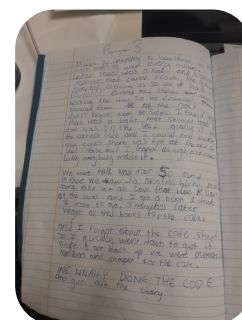
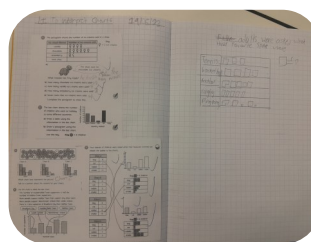
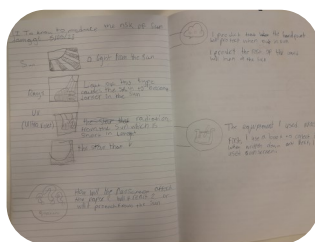
STAR LEARNER OF THE WEEK Year 2 - 3
