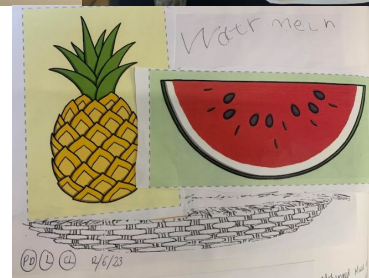
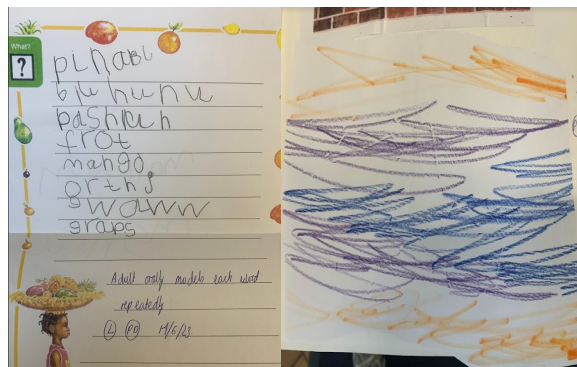

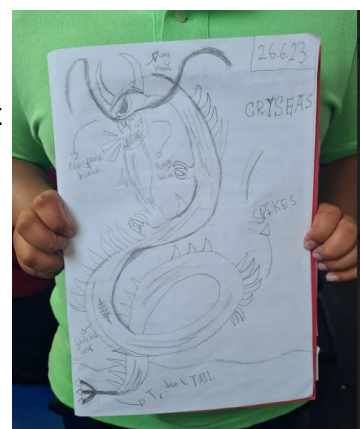
STAR LEARNER OF THE WEEK Year 2 - 3

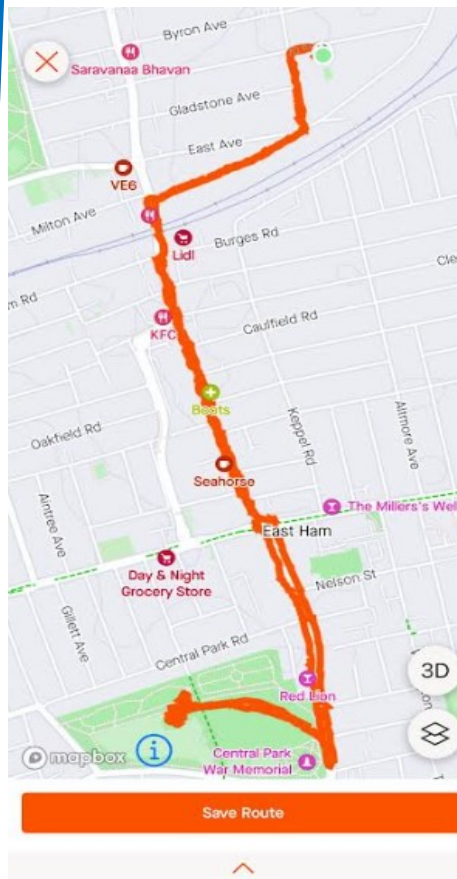


STAR LEARNER OF THE WEEK Year 4 - 6
