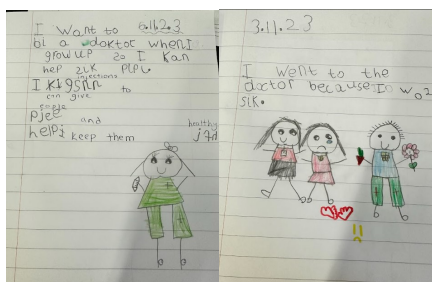

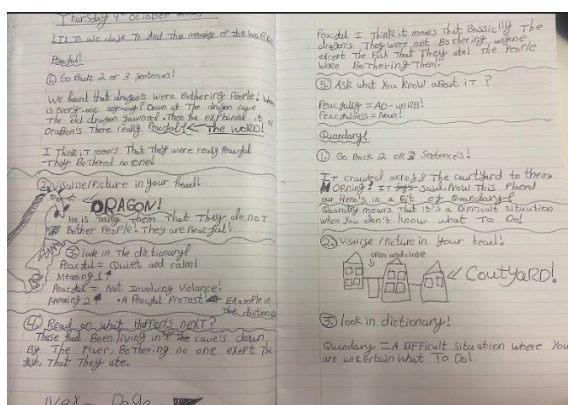
STAR LEARNER OF THE WEEK Year 2 - 3

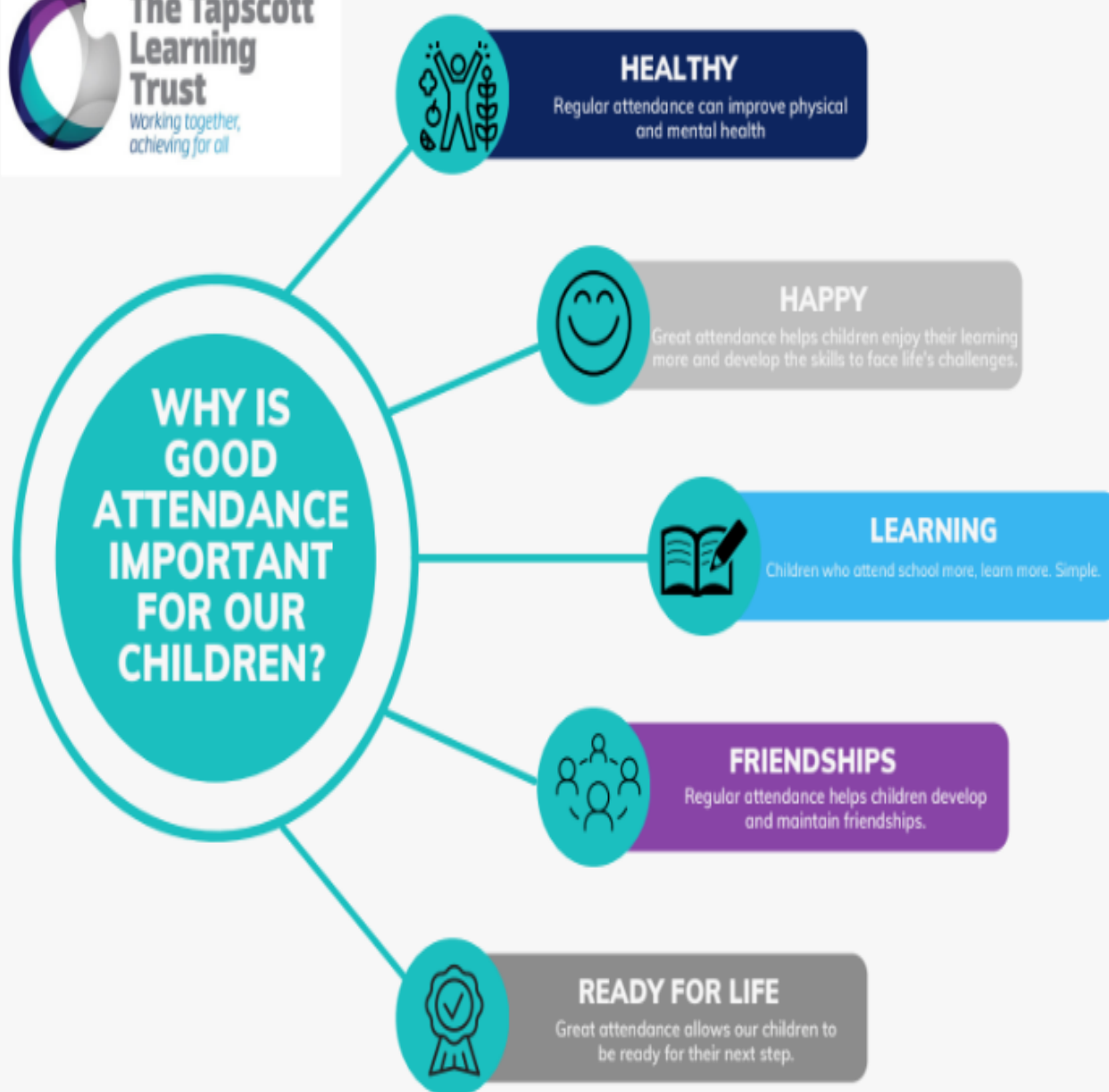
