## Star Learners this Week are:

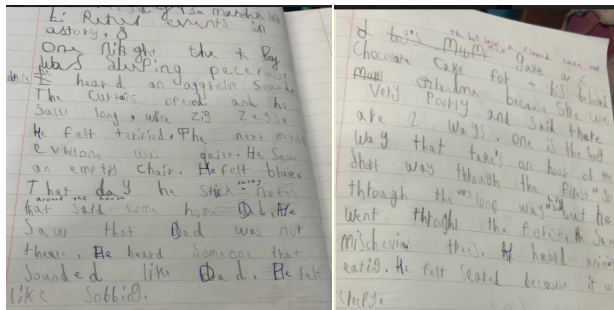
### STAR LEARNER OF THE WEEK EYFS & Year 1
