

Literacy

Beginning to use vocabulary influenced by experience of books. Use some of their print and letter knowledge in their early writing. For example: writing a pretend shopping list that starts at the top of the page; write 'm' for mummy.

Mathematics

Recognising and naming 2D shapes and their properties. Beginning to recognise and name some 3D shapes. Understanding and using positional language. Solve real world mathematical problems with numbers up to 5. Know that the last number reached when counting a small set of objects tells you how many there are in total. Make comparisons between objects relating to size, length, weight and capacity. Notice and correct an error in a repeating pattern.

Understanding of the World

Recognising changes over time such as; different seasons and weather. Talking about why things happen and how things work. Recognising and describing special events.

Personal, Social, & Emotional Development

Taking turn and sharing in everyday situations. Beginning to know how to solve problems without involving adults. Confidently speaking about own needs, wants, interests and opinions and feelings. Develop appropriate ways of being assertive.

Expressive Art & Design

Capturing experiences using different media such as; dance, paint and other materials. Creating simple representations of events, people and objects. Explore colour and colour-mixing. Sing the pitch of a tone sung by another person. Draw with increasing complexity and detail, such as representing a face with a circle and including details. Show different emotions in their drawings and paintings, like happiness, sadness, fear etc.

Physical Development

Use a comfortable grip with good control when holding pens and pencils. Confidently dress and undress independently. Beginning to recognise which foods are healthy and unhealthy.

Introducing a story line or narrative into play. Using intonation and rhythm, speaking with expression. Beginning to confidently hold a two way conversation.
