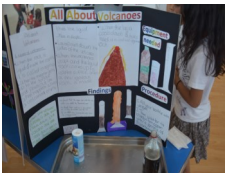


Nursery applications for September 2016

Clean for the Queen

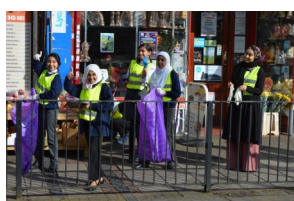
Last Friday 4th March, Kensington Primary took part in the 'Clean for the Queen' project in Manor Park.
