Scarlet Fever outbreak in schools

We have been advised by Public Health England to be vigilant in the wake of a rise in outbreaks of scarlet fever.

There are between 3,000 and 4,000 cases of the bacterial disease each year, but Public Health England (PHE) has reported a rise in recent months.

Government guidance states the disease initially causes headaches, sore throats, fever, nausea and vomiting and goes on to form a red, generalised pinhead rash, which gives skin a sandpaper-like texture.

If you see signs of scarlet fever then please ring your doctor promptly for antibiotic treatment.

Pupils and staff should stay away from school for the first 24 hours of treatment.

PHE warned that the disease, which is most likely to occur in children under 10, can spread quickly in schools.

Good hygiene practice such as hand-washing remains the most important step in preventing and controlling spread of infection.

Please encourage your children to always wash their hands both at school and at home.
